# We Can Exercise Your Pet While Boarding!

Therapeutic exercise can provide a wide range of benefits for pets. It can be used to increase range of motion, flexibility, endurance, strength and proprioception. Exercise can help keep canine athletes at peak performance levels.

### Water treadmill-

Using hydrotherapy treatment combines water exercising with the benefits of using a treadmill. This treadmill promotes weight loss by increasing the pet's metabolism. This machine can be beneficial for improving their mobility as it is great for rehabilitation. It will help to improve strength, muscular and cardiovascular endurance. The water treadmill treatment will help use your pet's energy in a constructive manner while boarding.

### Balance exercises-

Balance exercises designed to strengthen weak muscles and build up limbs affected by atrophy. These exercises include balancing on physio-balls, wobble boards and balance boards. Balance exercises can be useful in animals recovering from surgery. The animal is forced to place weight on the surgical repair, building muscle in the affected area. These exercises can also be helpful for animals with neurological conditions. For example, an animal recovering from a stroke has decreased coordination and balance which can be improved through a physical therapy regime that includes balance exercise.

### Massage-

Massage therapy has many physiological benefits for the patient. The physiological effects of canine massage include the following:

- Improved circulation
- Endorphin release
- Increased toxin excretion
- Relaxation and tension relief
- Reduced stiffness helping to restore mobility to injured areas
- Improving mental focus and behavior

Canine massage therapy should not be used as a substitute for veterinary medical care. However, when used in combination with medical care, it can help enhance the recovery process in many medical cases. In particular, canine massage used for rehabilitation purposes can include the following benefits:

- Help to relieve age related problems
- Provide relief from muscle tension, soreness, spasms, and weakness

In addition, canine massage can improve emotional well-being for the animal. Massage therapists often work with animals to calm hyperactivity, anxiousness, and nervousness.
